The journal was founded in 1957 and publishes papers on ancient and medieval Indian languages, literature, philosophy, and religion, ancient and medieval Iran, and papers on Tibet. In recent issues it has published linguistic articles on Sanskrit, Middle Indian (Pakrit), New-Indo-Aryan, on Munda linguistics (including the results of field-work), old and modern Dravidian languages (including fresh material on little known Central Dravidian languages). *Indo-Iranian Journal* also contains reviews of new publications in the fields covered by the journal. However, archaeological and specific historical studies are normally excluded.

Volume 26 contains indexes to Vols. 1–20.
