### 3. Conference on Tall Buildings, Hong Kong and Guangzhou, 10–15 December 1984

The organizing committee takes pleasure in inviting engineers, architects, scientists and mathematicians all over the world to participate in the Third International Conference on Tall Buildings to be held three days in Hong Kong and two days in Guangzhou in December 1984.

The Conference is organized jointly by The Hong Kong Institution of Engineers, Structural Division, The Department of Civil Engineering, University of Hong Kong, The Architectural Society of Guangdong, China and The Civil Engineering Society of Guangdong, China. It is also sponsored by International Association for Bridge and Structural Engineering and Council on Tall Buildings and Urban Habitat.
