### **Duration of holiday:**

 approximately 5 weeks within the months of July and August, according to holiday dates in country of residence.

### Holiday possibilities:

in Swiss families

 for children from 7–14 years (invitees 7–16) whose parents are able to make a small or no contribution.

in children's homes

- for children in bad health
- for children of 7–10 whose parents, according to their income, are able to pay the whole or main part of the cost.
   Cost per day and child: 17 to 27 Swiss francs, everything included.

in camps

 children from 10–14 who like simple holidays, happy companionship, sport and hiking and whose parents are able to pay all or nearly all the cost.

Cost per day and child: 17–27 Swiss francs, all included.

 in Europe in accompanied groups by train. In case of necessary air travel children are met at airport in Switzerland. Travelling cost borne by parents or by arrangement.

Next summer the Swiss Event of the year 1977 will be held in Vevey: the famous FÊTE DES VIGNE-RONS.



Participate in the special day for Swiss people living abroad: Saturday, 13th August 1977.


