


Diagram explaining the exercise of political rights at federal level by the Swiss abroad

Remarks:

For the Swiss abroad who has never been resident in Switzerland, the polling Commune where his vote is counted, is automatically his Commune of origin or one of his Communes of origin.

For the Swiss abroad who has already been resident in Switzerland, the place where his vote is counted, i.e. the polling Commune, may be according to his choice:

- a) his Commune of origin or one of his Communes of origin, or
- b) one of his former Communes of residence in Switzerland.

Important:

The Swiss abroad has also the right to sign Referenda and Initiatives. He will have to be careful to put his name on a list which refers to his polling Commune.

Vocational Training in Switzerland of Young Swiss from abroad

This heading is identical with the main theme of the 54th Assembly at Morat in August 1976. Along general lines, the problems could be clarified which face the young Swiss from abroad who wish to complete their education and training in Switzerland.

The main disadvantage mostly lies in the fact that foreign certificates and diplomas are not fully accepted, for admission procedures take into consideration the standard of education of the candidate in the first and his nationality only in the second place. This procedure is understandable and also an advantage to the Swiss from abroad, for it gives him the assurance that he has the necessary qualifications in order to reach the expected goal. You will find a list of schools, universities and vocational training centres. Inevitably it is not a complete list, for in nearly every Canton there are

- technical colleges
- art and craft colleges
- architectural colleges
- advisory offices for apprentices and career offices
