



The new one hundred-franc note, presented by Mr Leo Schürmann, Director of the Swiss National Bank.




Bishop Lefèbvre of Ecône dismissed by a papal decree.

The devastation caused by the drought – the corn does not ripen.




Jean-Louis Jeanmaire, brigadier and spy.
