
**2** Heavy snow falls in February caused several avalanches which demanded a number of lives and created a lot of damage.

**5** Approximately 10000 people gathered on the Bundesplatz during the parliamentary spring session and demanded immediate steps against perishing forests.






**7** Differences of opinion regarding the demolition of the church in the Fribourg Commune of Villarepos.




