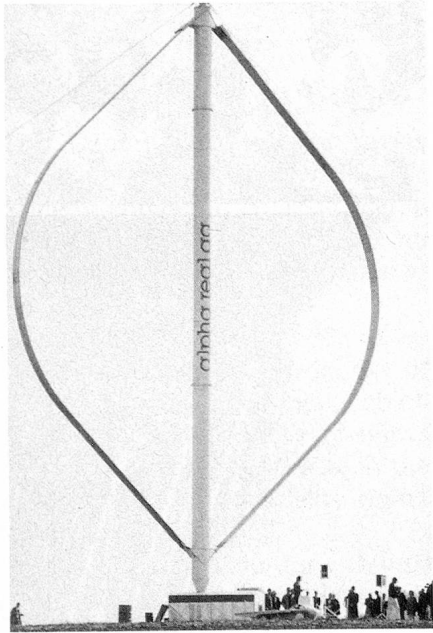

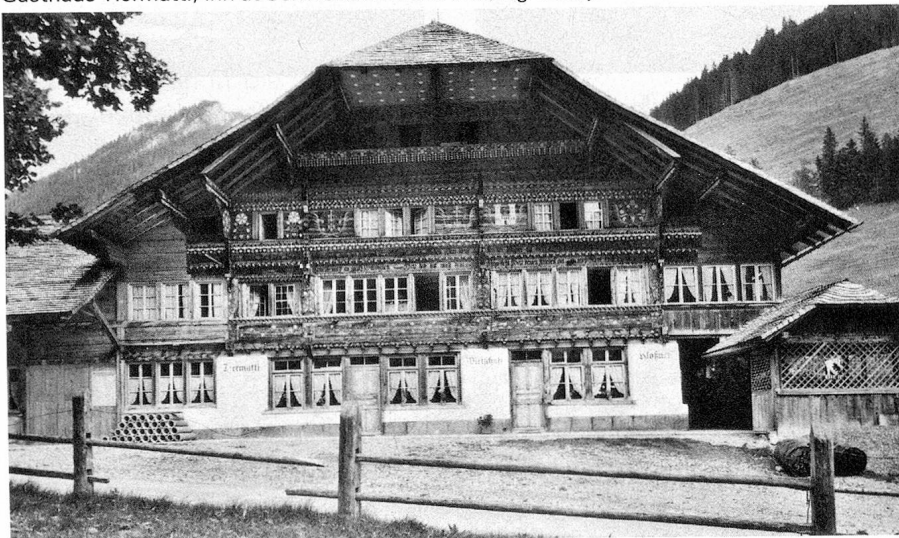
Europe's largest wind-power ▲ plant

Telegrams

- 1st march, 1986: Confederation puts stringent **clean air maintenance** regulations into force.
- Federal Council announces credit for building the projected **Vereina line** of the Rhaetian railway to the Lower Engadine.
- **Taxable capacity of cantons:** Zug at the top, Jura at the bottom.
- 1985: 17.3% **fewer road casualties** thanks to 50/75 mph speed limit.
- **«Pro Sport»:** new postage stamps with surcharge.
- **The advent of the Pill** and subsequent fall in the birthrate is now manifest in colleges and universities.
- From 1st July, 1986: **phosphates** in washing powders to be banned.
- New: **«Sunshine» registers** for 3,029 communes, to promote the use of solar energy.
- As from the New Year, the FHD (Womens' Auxiliary Service) has been renamed MFD (**Military Women's Service**). Chief is Brigadier Johanna Hurni.
- Since January, the SRG (Swiss Broadcasting Company) has been transmitting all VHF **radio programmes in stereo**.
- Scheduled **Swissair** flights now to Birmingham, Malta, Anchorage and Seoul.
- **Annual inflation rate**, 1985: 3.4%; **unemployment:** 1%.
- Regular **passenger trains** between Leuk and Visp reach **100 mph** for the first time in Switzerland.
