Dear Readers,

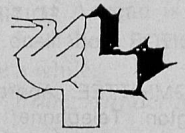
This is the first edition of the SWISS REVIEW printed in Switzerland and dispatched from there directly to you. Up till now, the Secretariat for the Swiss Abroad mailed the general text ready for printing via the Swiss Embassy in Wellington to the Editing Committee of the Helvetia who added the text for the local pages before sending the lot to the printer in Stratford. The finished magazines were sent to the Embassy for distribution. The small number of Readers not registered at the Embassy got their Swiss Review through the Editing Committee who for this purpose received extra copies directly from the printers. The Secretariat for the Swiss Abroad who has been paying for the printing of the Swiss Review, even while it was done in Stratford, decided - for economic reasons - to henceforth print the paper for all countries - not just New Zealand - in Berne. The Editing Committee will get enough copies to continue sending the Swiss Review to the non-registered Readers. At the same time, the local pages were reduced from 5 to 4.

It is very much in the interest of the Clubs to advertise their activities also in the Swiss Review as it reaches a far wider readership than the Helvetia. Deadlines with the editor and arrival dates for the four 1988 issues are:

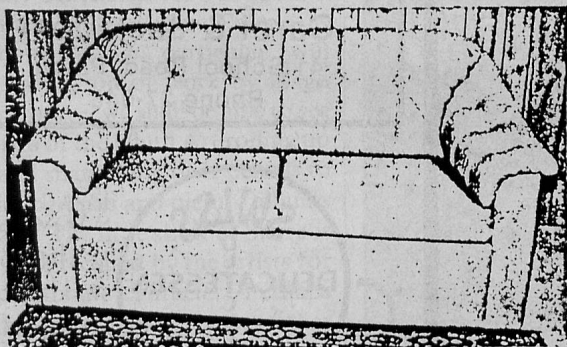

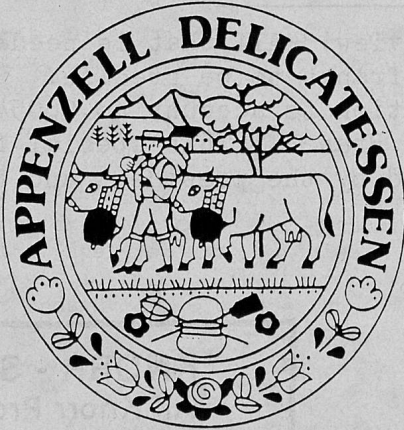
