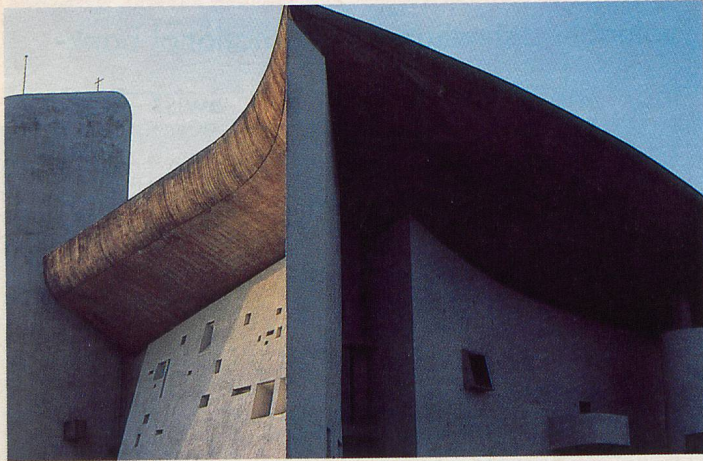

## How well do you know your Switzerland?

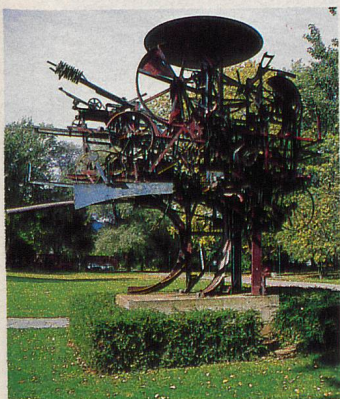
