### SRI Audio Service

The thousands of Swiss living abroad now have the possibility to exercise their political rights on the federal issues being voted on in Switzerland. To help keep them informed, SRI, prior to each federal vote, produces an audio cassette in which the issue being voted on is discussed and the main arguments presented. These cassettes are about one hour in length and are available in French, German and Italian about six weeks before voting day. This gives expatriate Swiss enough time to develop an opinion and make their decision by postal ballot. Persons interested in this audio-cassette offer should write to:

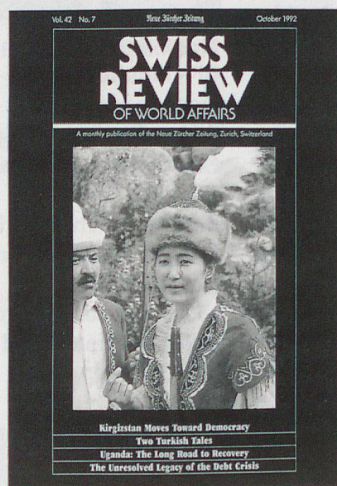
