Schweiz Switzerland on in Sicht in Sight

The four-language information and communication platform "Switzerland in sight" (http://schweiz-in-sicht.ch) provides a stimulating and multifaceted view of modern Switzerland.

"Switzerland in sight" is a multimedia window on the most important geographical, social, cultural and political aspects of Switzerland. At the same time it networks on-line users from all over the world with other Swiss and enables a lively dialogue across national borders.

The highly educational and informative collection of material is also an ideal tool for foreignlanguage instruction and provides a varied insight into the realities of multilingual Switzerland. "Switzerland in sight" is based on the eponymous printed version issued by the Co-ordinating Committee for the Presence of Switzerland Abroad, an official government organ for disseminating information abroad.

Attractive learning materials

"Switzerland in sight" is divided into eight main sections. The first four present Switzerland in subject-specific units (landscape and living space, economy and science, population and society, federalism and multilingualism), offering SRG SSR idée suisse radio and TV programmes and Swiss literary texts read by professional actors. Interactive graphics present information in an attractive format and visualise inter-relationships. A comprehensive list of links connects users to additional information available on the internet.

The chapter on "Teaching and learning" provides students and teachers with ideas on how to use "Switzerland in sight" as a learning tool for specific topics and for active language instruction. An electronic dictionary allows users to check and extend their vocabulary. Games help to test the knowledge acquired.

The "community" section is just as varied. Here you can e-mail a partner in Switzerland or another country for a chat session. Or make up your own home page and send electronic postcards. The www.swissinfo.org news section provides up-to-date information on current events in Switzerland.

To make the most of the multimedia content, your computer must fulfil certain requirements. All the necessary information is available in the Help section. "Switzerland in sight" is continually edited and updated and appears in German, French, Italian and English. For enquiries, please contact:
