CSA Infoboard. Congress 2009 Report

The yearly Congress of the Swiss Abroad took place in Lucerne on Saturday, 8 August 2009, and the Council of the Swiss Abroad had its annual meeting on Friday 7 August 2009...

Some 700,000 Swiss or Swiss with dual nationalities, representing about 10% of the total population, are registered abroad and of those, some 120,000 are registered to vote in Switzerland.

The main objectives of the Organisation of the Swiss Abroad (OSA) comprise for the next few years are to: consolidate the rights of the Swiss abroad and represent them at Swiss federal and cantonal levels, foster political participation of the Swiss abroad, further expand information services to the Swiss abroad, build an internet platform for the Swiss abroad community, assist consolidation of the institutions of the Swiss abroad, and generally act as a "competence centre" for all matters relating to the Swiss abroad.

In particular, the Council of the Swiss Abroad (CSA) was briefed on the project of **electronic voting** by the Swiss abroad and half of the cantons should be ready with that programme by 2012, and then all of Switzerland by about 2015 (even federal votes are organised by the cantons). Problems to be overcome are mainly in the security area and we have been adviced that most European countries have given up on this project for that reason. The organisation encourages increased participation of the Swiss abroad in the political debate in Switzerland and in the number of Swiss registered to vote from abroad.

The Council of the Swiss Abroad also asked the federal authorities to reconsider editing six [6] annual "Swiss Review" issues instead of the current four [4], in printed and electronic versions, and to increase the budget accordingly.

Various federal representatives and personalities from the Diplomatic Corps and from other Swiss institutions honoured the role of the OSA and recognised their role as ambassadors for the Swiss cause. This should give the Swiss from abroad additional political "weight".

SwissInfo [www.swissinfo.ch] has a pivotal role and task to inform the Swiss abroad on all aspects of Switzerland. The Congress approved also an appeal to the federal authorities to approve and provide SwissInfo with enough financial and personnel resources to fulfil this task. In another resolution, the Council of the Swiss Abroad appealed to the Swiss authorities to acknowledge the growing importance of the Swiss living abroad.



The Council also approved a resolution to condemn those large **Swiss Banks** which choose to close bank accounts of Swiss nationals in the USA.


