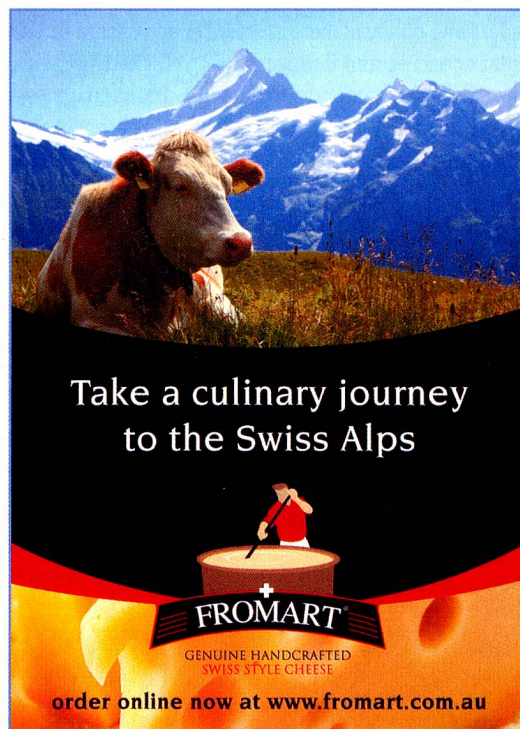
Symposium "Bilateral Scientific Opportunities Between Switzerland and Australia" held in Melbourne on Monday, November 8, 2010

In collaboration with the Embassy of Switzerland, the Swiss Australian Academic Network (SAAN) organized an international Symposium to identify gaps and emerging opportunities as well as to proactively develop and foster strategies that enable and facilitate collaborative research opportunities between Australia and Switzerland.



With the President of the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF), Prof Dieter Imboden, delivering the keynote address, this well attended event, included a dozen speakers from academia, industry, funding agencies and government. The Symposium, held in Melbourne at Australia's premier biomedical research Institute (The Walter and Eliza Hall Institute of Medical Research), raised discussions relating to the further development of practical and high level strategies to foster, promote and strengthen a wider range of scientific collaborations and exchanges between the best and most talented academics in Australia and Switzerland.

There was unanimous acknowledgment among participants that bilateral collaborations are, in general, driven by individual researchers or research groups rather than being mandated at political levels or by funding agencies. However, several speakers stressed the need for the latter organizations to expand overarching frameworks to enable a further increase to the already substantial flow of bilateral research money. Indeed, Australia is currently ranked 7th by countries where SNSF funding is awarded (approx. 35M AUD per year), with Switzerland ranking 11th by countries where funding is awarded to by the Australian Research Council ARC.
