## **Promises and reality**

There are always plenty of major announcements and promises made during election campaigns. Many of these are often quickly forgotten again in day-today political life. We have therefore produced a summary of the voting at the National Council over the past four years on proposals directly affecting Swiss citizens abroad.

In the table below, proposals voted on in the previous legislature (2008–2011) are divided into two groups – issues that directly concern

the Swiss abroad and those that might have an impact on the Swiss abroad. The voting behaviour of political parties and not of individual members of parliament is shown. Exact figures are given where the voting was close.
