The Glacier Express links the two most important regions in the Swiss Alps, Valais and Graubünden. On board, you will travel through 91 tunnels and cross 291 bridges between Zermatt, the home of the Matterhorn, and St. Moritz, the glamorous station of the Engadin. In its panorama cars, a journey of over seven hours will seem like just a few minutes, as the views of nature in Winter are so magnificent. From the highest point of the journey, the Oberalp Pass (2033 m), through the gorges of the Rhine, the entire route shows you a succession of forests with trees cloaked in white, silent plains and typical mountain villages.

An unforgettable journey

Since its first journey in 1930, the Glacier Express has lost none of its magic, particularly in Winter. It took 50 years before trains were able to run on the impassable mountain section of the Furka in Winter!

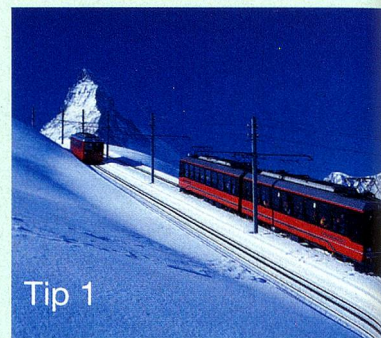
