BERNE, 6th May 1936. On this date, a Pack-column, consisting of 4 horses and a dog, under the leadership of Corporal Pfeuti and Film Photographer Herrman, returned to Berne after an absence of seven months. They left Berne on the 8th October, 1935, visiting Austria, Hungary, Rumania, Bulgaria, Turkey, Greece, Albania and Southern Slovakia, a truly notable journey of 8,000 kilometers. They were heartily welcomed and congratulated by Colonel Haccius, Chief of the Military Depot, Berne.

LUCERNE, 10th May 1936: The opening of a new bridge was celebrated in the presence of a large gathering. The bridge, a wonderful piece of art, cost 1.3 Mill.Francis and has a total width of 26 meters - 14 meters for vehicular traffic and 6 meters footpath on each side.
