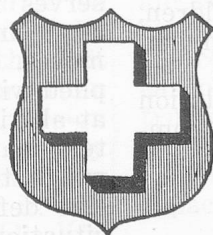

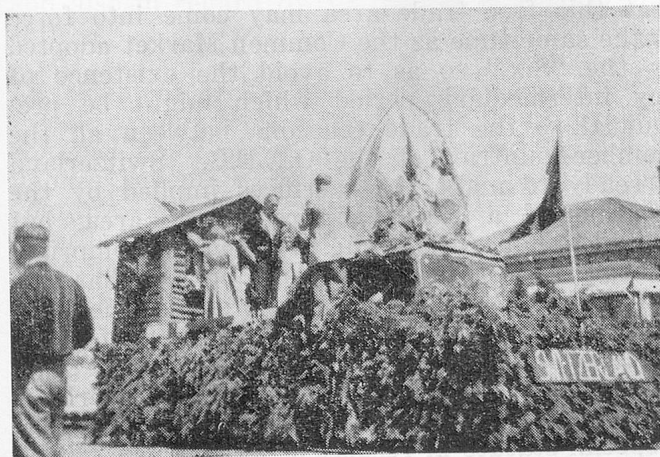
NOTICE
