Red Cross Centenary Function, 1963

In connection with the Red Cross centenary celebrations a function was held in Wellington on November 4th, consisting of Official Addresses, and a pageant entitled "From Solferino to Skopje," which illustrated the foundation of the Red Cross and its development.
