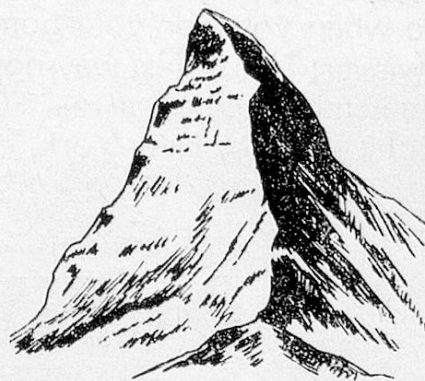
- To conserve, promote and advance the cultural standards of citizens of Swiss origin within New Zealand.
- To provide for the moral and the financial support of Swiss citizens living in New Zealand in urgent and deserving cases, in particular to care or provide for the needy families of living or deceased Swiss citizens, provide a decent burial and resting place for those who die without adequate means, and generally provide financial, moral or social assistance in any case in which the Committee thinks fit, but so that no person considered by the Committee and in the eyes of the Law of New Zealand or Switzerland to be of bad reputation or averse to honest work shall receive any assistance from the Society. Financial support in the term of this paragraph shall only be given in cases where Social Security benefits prove insufficient.
- To assist Swiss immigrants to learn the New Zealand way of life.
- To support the social and cultural contact among people of Swiss origin.

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
