Pharmaceutical Industry: Switzerland Comes 4th.

According to the calculations of the American Association of the Pharmaceutical Industry, the world medicines market represents some 20 to 22 billion dollars per year, with the prospects for 1980 lying somewhere between 40 and 50 billion dollars.
