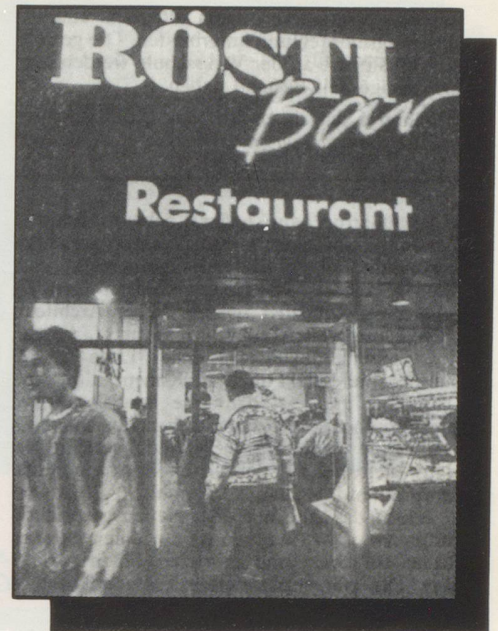

Although Rösti specialities have been available at the restaurant for over 10 years., the new Rösti-Bar is based on the Fast Food principle. The potatoes are pre-cooked, grated, portioned out and frozen. No more that 7 minutes are required from order to be served. Eighteen different toppings are being offered, including of course the ubiquitous rounds of cervelat.

An additional feature of the Rösti-Bar is the fact that there is enough room between tables to move around with your baggage trundler. You could call it a sort of "Drive-In" in miniature.

Len Chamberlain 1921 - 1992

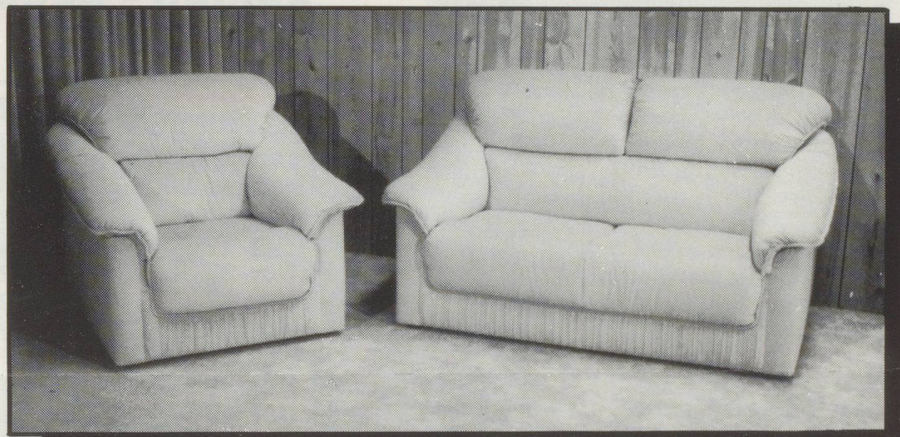
