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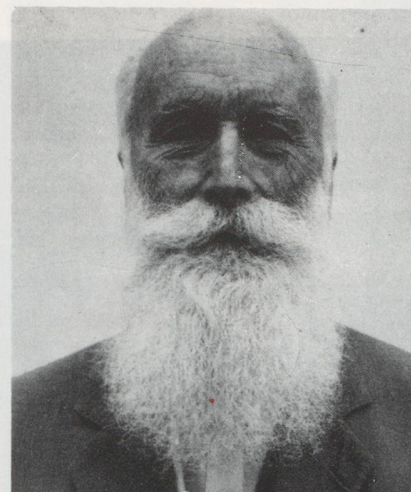
HAIRY STORY

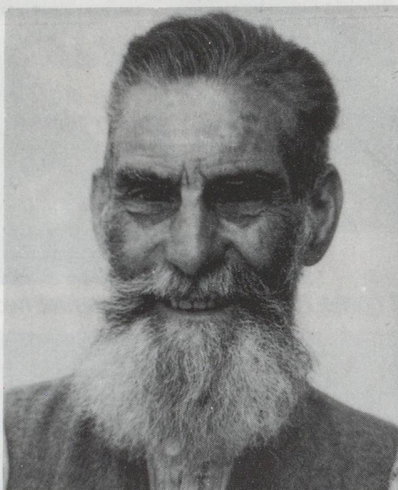
NATURE BEARD. Georg Zehetmair, 62. "Alpine beard competition, what a great idea. I grew a beard just to be able to take part in the contest".

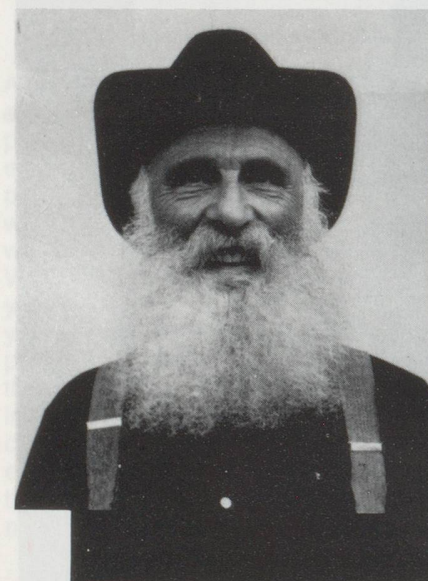
CURLY BEARD. Rico Clopath, 35. "No one is allowed near my beard, not even my wife. I treat my beard only with mild baby shampoo."
