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1st possibility to participate:

Expatriate Swiss children and teenagers at Expo.02

Purpose

- The «Expatriate Swiss children / teenagers at Expo.02» project would like to make it possible for expatriate Swiss children and teenagers from all continents to visit Expo.02, regardless of domicile and social circumstance

Participation

- CHF 10'000.- per child or teenager

Services offered by Expo. 02

- Stay in Switzerland (approximately 10 days)
- Assumption of part of the travel expenses
- Care during the stay in Switzerland
- A 3-day pass to EXPO.02

Procedure and idea

- ASO – expatriate Swiss organisation will organise the visit of the children and teenagers to Expo.02
- The ASO will administer contributions from patrons and use them to finance the described services
- Expo.02 will pay the balance to suitable Expo.02 projects



2nd possibility to participate:

Supporters of Expo.02

Purpose

- The sponsors will participate in one of the music clubs by engaging performers

Participation

- CHF 50'000.-

Services offered by Expo.02

- Admission tickets
- Event vouchers
- Presence at the club
- Right to use the supporter logo
- Purchase option for VIP packages
- Club lounge

Procedure and idea

- The patron pays Expo.02 the sum of CHF 50'000.- for a group of performers
- The patron chooses the group of performers for the club from a list prepared by Expo.02
- Expo.02 engages the selected performers
- Expo.02 produces the described performances for the benefit of the patrons

3rd possibility to participate:

The Expo. 02 Fund

Purpose

- The Expo.02 fund will be used to enable patrons to participate in the National Exhibition
- The Expo.02 fund will be open to anyone interested in Expo.02 and to whom the other forms of funding are for different reasons not accessible

Participation

- From CHF 1'000.-

Services provided by Expo. 02

- The donor will receive a certificate as well as a symbolic gift
- The donor will not tie his contribution to any specific service or project in return
- The money from the fund will be used directly to support the realisation of

infrastructures, special events and artistic performances on the Expo. 02 Arteplages
