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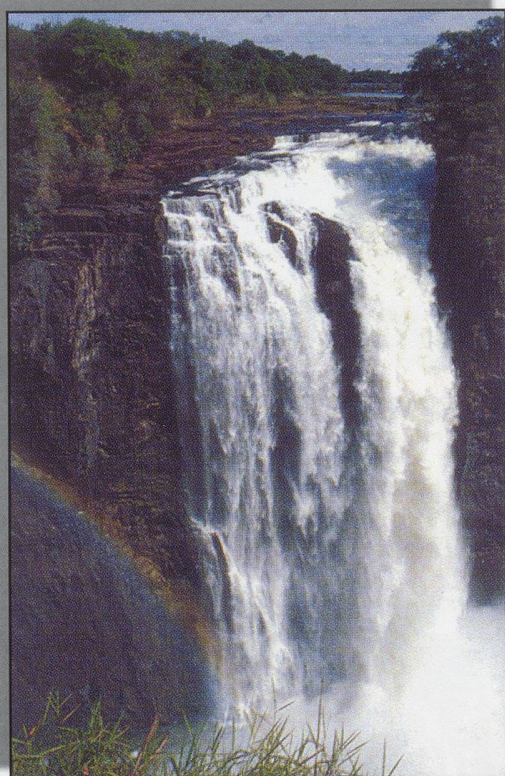

Where are the 7 natural wonders of the world?

The Seven Natural Wonders of the world is a listing of outstanding natural features of the Earth: **The Grand Canyon**, in the United States, is a breathtaking feature created by the erosion (wearing away) of rock by the Colorado River over a period of about 6 million years. **Mount Everest**, rising 8,850 metres (29,035 feet) above sea level, is the world's highest mountain. **Ayers Rock** is the world's largest monolith (single large stone). It rises 348 metres (1,142 feet) above the desert floor in central Australia. **The Matterhorn** is one of the most beautiful mountains on Earth. Its base is in Switzerland and Italy. **Victoria**

Falls is a waterfall on the Zambesi River in southern Africa, between Zimbabwe and Zambia. Meteor Crater, also known as **Barringer**

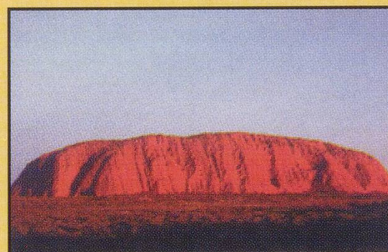


Crater, is a huge circular depression in the earth near Winslow, Arizona. **The Great Barrier Reef** is the world's longest group of coral reefs. It follows the coast of Australia for about 2,010 km (1,250 miles).



Fact File:

Ayers Rock is loaf-shaped and has a circumference of about 9 km (5½ miles). It is composed of red sandstone. Its name is Uluru in the language of Australia's Aboriginal people.



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
