## MYCOLOGIA HELVETICA — Instructions to Authors

Send original and two copies to the Senior Editor, H. Göpfert, Alpenblickstrasse 53, CH - 8630 Rütli, Switzerland. Receipt will be acknowledged and papers submitted to two reviewers. Acceptance may depend on revisions suggested by the editorial board. Papers that do not conform to the specifications are refused.

Manuscripts must not be submitted to other journals at any time.

Languages: Contributions may be written in English, French, German or Italian.

Scope of the journal: Contributions may belong to one of the following categories: Original papers: Ecology, experimental mycology, genetics, medical mycology and mycotoxins, partial and full monographs, morphology, cytology, plectology, classical and computer assisted taxonomy, systematics, nomenclature. Priority is given to papers dealing with higher fungi. Contributions to industrial mycology are excluded. Short notes are original contributions up to two printed pages long. Book reviews are welcome. Review articles summarize research results of the last few years in a restricted field. Calendar of events. Isolated descriptions of new or critical species, with or without a coloured plate. Priority is given to higher Basidiomycetes and higher Ascomycetes.

Abstracts are required in two languages, preferably in English and in one of the other admitted languages. The editorial board may provide help for translation. The abstracts should not exceed 500 words and are required for all papers exceeding 3 pages of text. Every abstract should be written in an informative style that permits its use without revision by abstracting services. Give essential details of techniques or research findings. Avoid generalizations and statements with low information content, like "... are reported", "... have been given..", "... was investigated..", "...have been carried out..".

Citation of taxonomical authorities must follow the latest edition of the International Code of Botanical Nomenclature. Do not cite authors in titles or in abstracts.

Preparation of manuscripts: All manuscripts must be submitted READY FOR OFFSET printing, including all illustrations and legends.

All text and illustrations must fit within a rectangle of 148 x 220 mm when using 12 pitch printing (12 characters per inch), or they must fit within a rectangle of 177 x 263 mm when using a 10 pitch printing.

Type all text in one and a half line spacing, including footnotes, references, legends, etc. on only one side of a letter-sized paper (European A4 format or close to it). Use carbon ribbon to type the text.

Leave a blank space of five lines at the beginning of the manuscript, followed by the centered title in upper case characters. Name(s) and address(es) of the author(s) are written in normal typing using upper and lower case characters. They must be centered. See the current issue for examples.

Figures and tables must have a legend. Combine the illustrations and legends to fit the rectangles specified above. All legends must be explanatory; do not simply refer to the main text. Do not use any kind of underlining, except simple underlining of Latin names when italics cannot be used. Footnotes should be avoided.

Illustrations may be original line drawings executed in indian ink or high contrast black and white photographs on glossy paper. Coloured illustrations are of two types: photographs and original paintings. Acceptance of coloured illustrations depends on financial possibilities. Use of scale markers is required for microscopic details, recommended for all other illustrations. All figures should be numbered individually. Do not combine photographs and drawings on the same plate.

References are alphabetic, not numbered lists at the end of the paper. Complete names, titles, and first and last pages are required; e.g. Watling, R., G.A. Kile and N.M. Gregory, 1982: The genus *Armillaria* - nomenclature, typification, the identity of *Armillaria mellea* and species differentiation. *Trans. Brit. Mycol. Soc.* 78: 271-285.

(If an author prefers she/he may send in first of all a normally typed manuscript that is not yet ready for offset printing. It is only the definitive text, which takes into consideration the suggestions the Board of Reviewers might make, that must in any case be submitted ready for offset printing.)

Page and editorial charges: The author will not be billed for publication of offset ready manuscripts that do not include coloured illustrations, but a charge is made for text that must be rewritten. Separate charges will be made for coloured illustrations, depending on the actual cost of printing of coloured plates. The charges are intended to be paid from funds supporting the work reported, and under no circumstances from the author's personal incomes. If an author does not have the resources to meet the charges, they may be waived by writing to the Senior Editor without jeopardizing the publication of either the manuscript in question or other manuscripts that may be submitted in the future. Acceptance of the manuscript does not depend on the payment of the charges.

Reprints must be ordered when submitting the paper or on receiving the note of acceptance. Authors will receive 50 reprints free of charge but will be billed for additional copies according to actual printing costs.

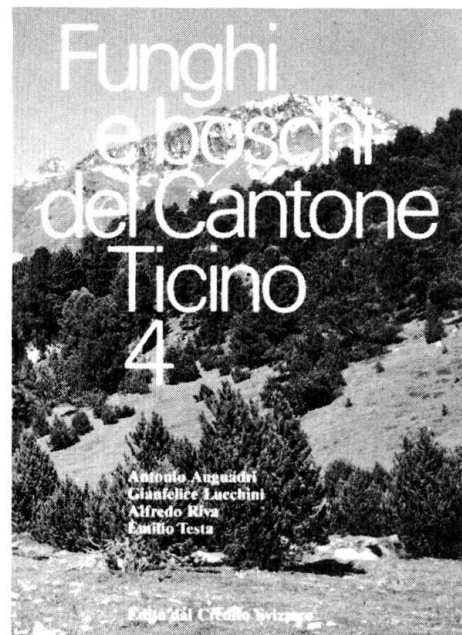
