## **International Mineralogical Association (IMA)**

### **Fourteenth General Meeting, July 1986**

The 14th General Meeting and Congress of the International Mineralogical Association (IMA) will be held in Stanford, USA, July 13–18, 1986.

No IMA General Meeting will be held in 1984. However, Section 10 Mineralogy of the International Geological Congress in Moscow, August 4–14, 1984, is being organized in collaboration with IMA. An announcement on the scientific program of Section 10 has been published in *Phys. Chem. Minerals* volume 9, issue 2.

The 1986 Meeting of IMA will be held on the campus of Stanford University, Stanford, California, USA. This Meeting, sponsored by the Mineralogical Society of America, will be accompanied by a full program of scientific sessions, field trips, cultural events, and local trips to points of interest in the San Francisco Bay area.

The Organizing Committee expects to run at least three field excursions of mineralogical and petrological interest to localities in California. Also, if there is enough interest, it may be possible to sponsor a field trip in Alaska, a trip to the Cascade Mountain Range in Washington and Oregon, and possibly to Hawaii.

The *Organizing Committee* consists of Gordon E. Brown, Stanford University; Gerald Czamanske, US Geological Survey; Subrata Ghose, University of Washington; Henry O. A. Meyer, Purdue University; and Charles T. Prewitt, SUNY Stony Brook (Chairman).
