Dear Compatriot,

As the result of an amicable understanding with the Consistoire of the Eglise Suisse the Swiss Colony of London will soon see the dawn of an event, which may be regarded as of historical significance. When the Eglise Suisse was founded, more than 150 years ago, our Colony consisted in its majority of French Swiss, but since then a great change has taken place, the number of German Swiss members having in recent years increased to such an extent that a regular religious service on Sunday mornings, in our own language and in accordance with our own custom, has become an urgent necessity. It having been found impracticable to alter the existing order of service at the Eglise Suisse, the creation of an extended church organisation with this object in view has, therefore, been taken in hand, and thus a spiritual need among the Allemanic section of the Colony is being answered. While the Eglise Suisse will continue, as hitherto, to hold services for the benefit of the French Swiss compatriots, the proposed new Church will be a place of worship for the German Swiss community in London.
