THIRTY-SIXTH ANNUAL REPORT OF THE SWISS RELIEF COMMITTEE, LIVERPOOL.

For the Year 1933.

During the Year under review we spent on Relief £69 1s. 6d., plus Expenses £2 5s. 6d., making a total of £71 7s. 0d., as compared with £86 3s. 1d. in 1932.

Our income from invested funds amounted to £32 19s. 4d.; Donations to £36 3s. 0d., and Refunds to £7 0s. 0d., a total of 76 2s. 4.

It gives the Committee much pleasure to record that the special Appeal made in the Report for 1932 met with a very good and generous response, especially considering the unsettled times through which we are passing, and we take advantage of this opportunity to express our gratitude and thanks to all our friends, near and far, who have so kindly contributed towards placing our funds on a better basis. As already intimated, it is our intention to increase our funds, so that the income from the same may suffice to meet our obligations. In addition to the amount of £36 3s. 0d., mentioned above, further Donations, amounting to 23 14s. 0d. have been received early in 1934, making a total of £59 17s. 0d. Whilst we are not again appealing for contributions, we need hardly say that if any of our friends feel disposed to send a further Donation, same will be gratefully received, as the "calls" made upon us are still heavy, and we are naturally anxious to assist our compatriots in distress as far as possible.

During 1932 we lent a fairly large sum to a Swiss who was in need of assistance, and we are now pleased to be able to report that we expect the full amount to be returned to us in a very short time.

In 1933 we lent £16 to a Swiss, out of work, and in very poor health, but this amount is fully covered by a Life Insurance Policy which is in the hands of our President, Mr. E. Montag, Consul for Switzerland. Another serious case on our books at the moment is that of a "cuisinier-pâtissier," married, with a family of three, who has only worked a few weeks during 1933. We may find it necessary, if the man does not get regular work, to place his case before the Authorities in Switzerland, as it is proving too big a drain on our resources. The other cases relieved do not require special mention.
