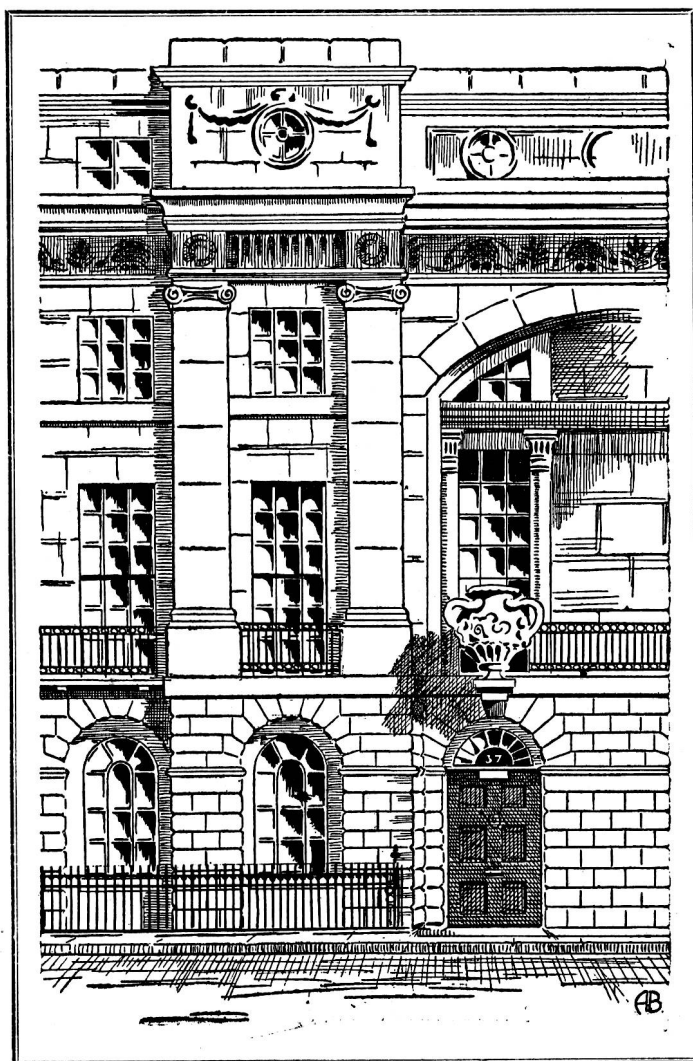

CLASSES FOR CHILDREN

THE DALCROZE METHOD leads children to concentrate, develops their memories, makes them more perceptive, helps them to lose self-consciousness, and provides them with a means for ordered self-expression. It gives them a foundation for creative expression, whether by means of the body, the voice, or through a musical instrument, by fostering rhythm, training the ear, and developing the power of improvisation in movement and at the piano.

Costume

In the Rhythmic Movement Classes students should be barefooted, and a special costume is necessary. Men: Jersey and shorts. Women: one of the two following:

(a) The School Costume as worn in the Training Department of the Dalcroze School, London, *i.e.*, two-piece swimming suit, price 10s. 0d., or

(b) Tunic to the knees, worn with directoire knickers to match. The most suitable material is crepe de chine. This cannot be obtained from the Dalcroze School.

Slippers are also needed and a kimono or long wrap for wearing over the costume when passing from dressing rooms to class rooms.
