Wie oft kam es vor, dass zuerst exportiert wurde und erst nachher über Zoll- und Kontingentierungsverhältnisse sowie über die Absatzmöglichkeiten der Ware und über die Vertrauenswürdigkeit des Bestellers oder Vermittlers Erkundigungen eingelesen wurden. Wie oft ist es vorgekommen, dass hiesige, langansässige Vertrauensleute von einem Geschäft abgeraten haben, das dann aber doch getätigt wurde, weil man dem Vertrauensmann persönliche Interessen unterschob.

THE STOCK EXCHANGE OF ZURICH.

(By Leu & Co.'s Bank Zurich).

Zurich, 7th September 1936.

As the political outlook in Europe was not particularly encouraging in August, the stock-exchange business remained, also on account of the holiday season, mostly dull. Small turnovers with slightly receding quotations for a great number of shares was usual. Trading, therefore, concentrated almost entirely upon a few stocks only, which had a market also in other places besides Zurich. A very decisive downward movement in connection with the Spanish civil war affected especially Hispano-Americana. They dropped as low as 950 and regained some of the lost territory, after it grew more public that this company's interests were almost entirely on South-American soil. More justified were set backs in Compania Sevillana de Electricidad, being a purely Spanish institution. A slight recovery since then increased also the value of this stock namely from 85 to 105. Also Cia Italo-Argentina suffered noticeably for a few days and lowered as far as 115. In the last week of August, however, the general trend turned more promising and presently Cia. are traded at 128. During most of this time the American railway stocks encountered much support by their favourably disposed home market. A sudden change of trend in Wall Street in the last few days of August, when prices dropped several points accompanied by considerable short-selling, mainly brought along by exaggerated fear of a European war, was of very short duration. Both Baltimore and Pennsylvania railroads gained to over 15 Francs. Also Royal Dutch were well disposed and improved considerably. A decisive change to higher quotations was registered in the first week of September. Fall opened with a very distinct bullish aspect. Elektrobank upon the prospects of maintaining its previous years' dividend rate of 5% advanced about 20 Francs to 390. Trust and Bank shares generally were well looked upon and their disposition is still firm. Among the Swiss industrials sudden buying increased prices and turnovers noticeably.

etc. Almost as an exception Nestlé sold for slightly under 840 and looked somewhat disinterested just as insurance stocks had a very small trading capacity. As a rule the bond market in August was not very agitated either. Swiss governmental securities enjoyed reasonable support and have been able to advance slightly, so their average yield is approximately 4.5% as against 4.6% one month ago. After considerable weakness the French securities were able to make up some of the losses. German bonds were slowly rising and their gains amount to several percents in the case of the Funding bonds, while Italian securities were neglected for a long time and seem to have revived somewhat only last week.
