SWISS NATIONAL DAY CELEBRATION.

Arrangements have been made for the members of the Swiss Colony in Great Britain to join in this year's celebration of our SWISS NATIONAL DAY, to be held at the CASINO THEATRE, LONDON, on Sunday, 27th July, 1947. (See advertisement.)

Admission will be BY TICKETS ONLY, which will be FREE OF CHARGE and must be applied for in advance. Applications should be made to THE FIRST OF AUGUST COMMITTEE, Swiss House, 35, Fitzroy Square, London, W.1, where tickets will be available as from the 7th July and can be obtained either by a personal call Mondays to Fridays between 6 and 7 p.m., or by post on condition that a 2½d. *Stamped and Addressed Envelope is Enclosed.*

The full name of each person for whom a ticket is required must be stated in the application.

The Casino Theatre holds about 1,750 people, and numbered and reserved tickets will be issued strictly in rotation. Early application is therefore advisable to save disappointment.

It will greatly help the Committee if ticket holders who find themselves prevented from attending the celebration will be kind enough to return their unwanted tickets *at once to The First of August Committee* at the address mentioned above for the benefit of other fellow countrymen.

In order to satisfy a general desire, there will be a long interval for friends to meet, and teas and other refreshments will be served.

And last but not least, it is hoped again that as many visitors as possible will wear national costume.
