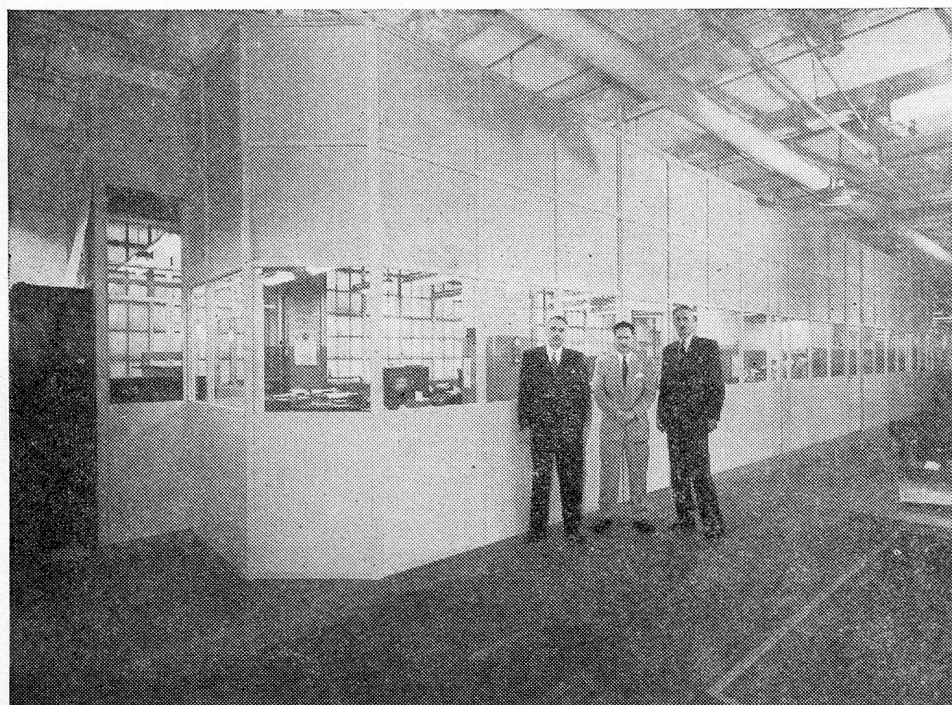

According to the above particulars the following cantons have up to today never been represented in the government: Uri, Schwyz, Unterwalden and Schaffhausen.

The cantons Vaud and Zurich take first place in government representation with 12 members each, the canton of Berne had 8 Federal Councillors, Neuchâtel 5, Ticino 5, Solothurn 4, St. Gall 4, Lucerne 3, Aargau 3, Thurgau 3, Geneva 3, Basle (both) 2, Grisons 2.

The following cantons had one representative each in the Federal Government: Glarus, Zug, Fribourg, Appenzel, Valais.

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
