The Annual General Meeting of the “Schweizerbund” (Swiss Club), took place on Saturday, February 26th, at 74, Charlotte Street, W.1.

Mr. F. Delaloye was in the Chair, and there were about 50 members present.

The President in his annual report mentioned, that in spite of a considerable drop in subscriptions, the accounts nevertheless show a small profit, principally due to the dances which are now held twice a week (Thursdays and Saturdays).

He acquainted the Meeting that a new seven years lease had been signed, thanking the lease holders and guarantors Messrs. George Bruscheiler, E. Nussle and W. Schneeberger for their efforts in this direction.

Mr. Delaloye thanked his colleagues on the committee for the loyal support they had given him, singling out Mr. R. Weist, who had held dual offices as Hon. Secretary and Treasurer.

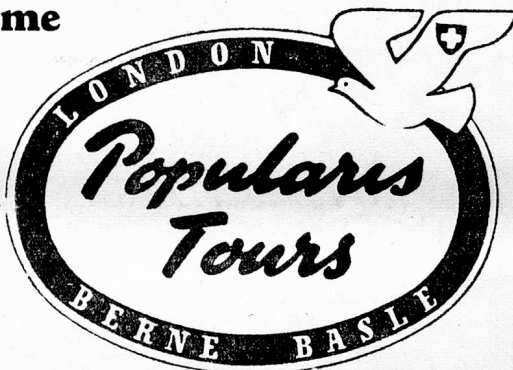
