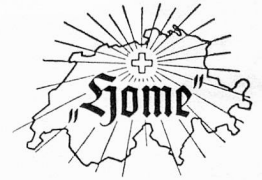

length of stay and the party travel tickets).

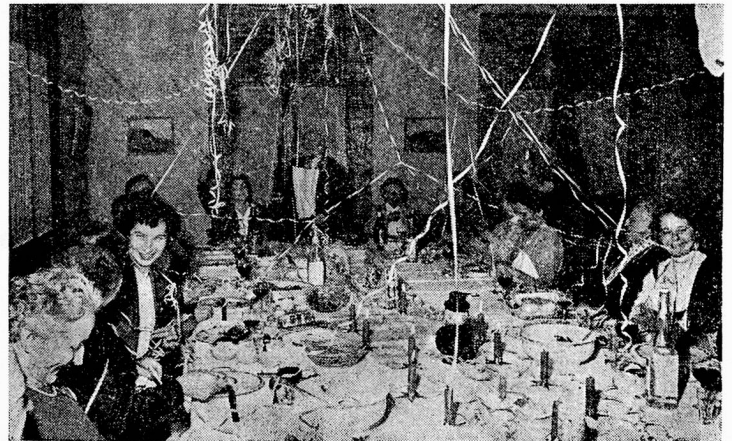
