ANNIVERSARIES

Professor Adolf Keller, well known in Swiss Protestant circles, who was at one time pastor of the German-speaking parish of Geneva, and secretary of the "Institut des sciences sociale" of the town of Geneva, has celebrated his 90th birthday.

Dr. Jakob Eugster has celebrated his 80th birthday, in Zurich. He was born in 1882, a citizen of Oberegg in Reute (Ct. Appenzell a.Rh.). On conclusion of his Law studies at the University of Zurich he practised for some time as a lawyer. In 1927 he was elected States Prosecutor of the canton of Zurich, a post which he held until 1940. From 1940 to 1947 Dr. Eugster was head of the Examination Authorities of the canton of Zurich. In 1929 he entered the "Kantonsrat" Zurich, over which he presided in 1938/39. The University of Zurich honoured him with the degree of *doctor honoris Causa*.

TO OUR READERS


The Advisory Council of the Swiss Observer wishes to inform the paper's readers and friends of certain changes in the editorship which have been decided upon.
