VOLI GEILER - WALTER MORATH

Thursday & Friday, 15th & 15th June 1962, at 7.30 p.m.
at the French Institute Theatre, Queensberry Place, S.W.7

We wish to direct the attention of our readers again to the two above-mentioned Gala Performances of the "European Rendez-Vous".

For more than a decade the two stars, Voli Geiler and Walter Morath, have constituted one of the smallest and most original theatrical companies of Europe.

At present the two artists are on a concert tour in America. Of their performance at Washington, which took place at the Conference Hall of the Swiss Embassy, the "Amerikanische Schweizer Zeitung" writes: "The audience of about 400 people was very enthusiastic by the genuinely Swiss features in Voli Geiler's and Walter Morath's art. The Swiss element in their family background was interpreted in a most lucid and witty way. A very specific Swiss quality of Geiler and Morath is their linguistic capacity. From number to number, they not

only change language, but, with the language, also their entire character. The whole enterprise was a real success for the artists, as well as for the Swiss Colony in Washington and its friends."

Of their performance in New York, at the Barbizon-Plaza theatre, the same paper reports: "The house was packed to capacity. Voli Geiler and Walter Morath kept their audience spellbound. The evening wasn't without a sombre note. The two artists are gifted buffons, who know their *métier*, and they are also diplomats! Their refined program proved it."

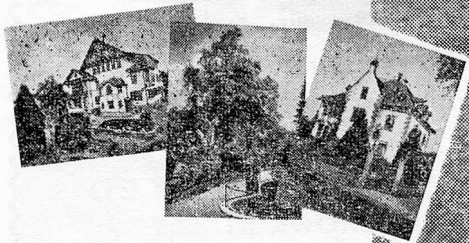
