Mr. Olivier Béguin, a member of the Swiss Colony in London, President of the Consistoire of the Swiss Church, recently received an honorary degree of Doctor of Humanities from St. Paul's University (Rikkyo University), Tokyo, one of the oldest Christian Universities in Japan. The degree was awarded in recognition of Mr. Béguin's services for prisoners of war during the Second World War, and of his present work as General Secretary of the United Bible Societies — the liaison body linking together all the Bible Societies throughout the world.

We should like to congratulate Mr. Béguin on this honour. It may interest readers that he has recently prepared a document on the Roman Catholic Church and the Bible which has now been published by Lutterworth Press at 5/-.
