SWISS ARTISTS TAKE THE BOW

The many one-man shows held in various parts of the country will be supplemented by several collective exhibitions to be seen shortly. The joint exhibitions of Swiss women painters, sculptresses and craftworkers is being organized by Geneva's "Musée Rath" from 2nd to 24th November. The artists of the Grisons will exhibit in the Fine Arts Museum in Chur from 17th November to mid-December, while the Villa Ciani in Lugano will be the setting for the show of the members of the Ticino chapter of the Association of Swiss Artists, Sculptors and Architects.
