SWISSAIR U.K. DC-9 SERVICES

The introduction of new Douglas DC-9 jets on the Manchester-Zurich route and on more services in Europe is among the features of Swissair's winter schedules effective from 1st November.

DC-9s will fly a weekend night tourist service between Manchester and Zurich, with an additional mid-week service from 22nd December. They will also continue to operate on the London-Basle-Zurich day and London-Zurich night flights. All of Swissair's London services will use Heathrow Airport during the winter timetable period.

Swissair has had two DC-9s in operation since August, and two more will come into service during the coming winter. The introduction of the new aircraft has been very successful and has fully come up to expectations.
