
LAST SWISS RAILWAY TO BE ELECTRIFIED

After decades of service with steam and diesel locomotives, the 25-mile Central Thurgau Line (Mittelthurgau-Bahn) has become the last private Swiss Railroad to be fully electrified. Founded in 1910, the line makes direct connections with the German Federal Railways system at Constance, and as an "international" branch line it experienced considerable difficulty during the confusion of two world wars. Today, the railway's management looks confidently toward the future, encouraged by the growing freight traffic between Switzerland and Southern Germany.
