Hermann Keller (75), Heiden (Appenzell A.Rh.), from 1912 to 1966 with the Rorschach-Heiden-Bergbahn; *Regierungsrat* from 1952 to 1955; for over 20 years Chairman of the Board of the Electricity Works of Heiden.

Dr. Emil Munz (66), Arbon, sociologist and father of Dr. Walter Munz, successor of Albert Schweitzer at Lambarene.

Admiral Howard Flanigan (78), Pregny (Geneva), American officer retired in Switzerland.

Jean Briner (90), Zurich, former typographer; Social Democratic Municipal Councillor from 1928 to 1942; National Councillor from 1926 to 1939 and 1940 to 1943; great merits with Zurich's educational development.

Georges de Meuron (84), Corcelles (Neuchâtel), President of the Council of the Nursing Home Préfargier; Liberal member of the Neuchâtel Parliament and Commune Councillor of Corcelles; President of the Society of Friends of the Arts of Neuchâtel.

Henri Lévy (75), Pully, former Director of the "Manufacture d'Horlogerie Pierce s.a." at Moutier and Bienna.

Major Hugo Bolli (54), Geneva, Commandant of the Geneva Cantonal Police; was killed in tragic accident when he wanted to release an injured bird and fell from the sixth floor.
