**BIG ORDER FOR SWISS BEER VATS**

Known as specialists in the manufacture of big aluminium tanks, the Swiss firm of Aluminiumschweisswerk AG at Schlieren (Aluminium Welding Works Co. Ltd.) recently received a large order from a Dutch brewery to produce a prototype of an unusually large vat for the storage of beer and to manufacture a series of them. The vats are to have a capacity of 430,000 litres of beer each and will measure approximately 13 feet in diameter and 115 feet long. Separated into two sections for transport down the river Rhine, these vats will be housed in a steel frame building 115 feet high, in which seven such tanks will be placed one on top of the other.
