750,000th LAND ROVER GOES TO INDIA ON MERCY MISSION

The 750,000th Land Rover to roll off the assembly lines of British Leyland's Rover Company's Solihull factory is on its way to India where it will do duty as a field ambulance with a SWISSAID Medical Mission, donated by MAT TRANSPORT AG of Switzerland. The ambulance was handed over by Rover Chairman, Sir George Farmer, to Mrs. K. J. Richards, wife of the Midlands Director of MAT TRANSPORT LIMITED, who acted as representative of the Directors and staff of the Swiss Company. The donation was being made to celebrate the twenty fifth anniversary of the founding of the Swiss Office.
