ARMCHAIR SKI-ING

A television series on ski-ing is currently being shown on ITV every Sunday morning at 11 a.m. "Ski-ing with Gina" began on 15th September and will last for thirteen weeks. A reception at the Swiss National Tourist Office in early September marked the opening of this original series, which may have inspired a long report on ski-ing in the Sunday Times Colour Supplement, 12th October.

The thirteen half-hour programmes shot entirely on location in Switzerland were produced by Yorkshire Television for the ITV network, and amount to a particuarly ambitious production. Besides instruction for all grades of ski-ing, the series also covers basic information on ski wear and equipment and introduces the short ski technique as well as the latest trend — Langlauf — all amid the sun and snow of some of Switzerland's most beautiful holiday areas.

In association with the programme, a book produced by Stanley Paul, and a wallchart by Pace Posters are on sale at all leading bookshops. The book is priced at £2.75 (hardback) and £1.50 (paperback). The illustrated wallchart is 90p (packed).
