Fly-Rail Switzerland



Fly-Rail Switzerland is a new concept in holidays, offering the speed and convenience of air travel with the possibility of unlimited travel on the Swiss Federal Railway trains, lake boats and most Alpine postal coaches. By taking advantage of our "Fly-Rail Switzerland" offer, you can enjoy a "go as you please"holiday in beautiful Switzerland at a very reasonable cost.

Fly-Rail Switzerland includes economy class air travel from London or Manchester to Geneva, Basle or Zurich and return by scheduled services of SWISSAIR, plus a Swiss Federal Railways Holiday Card valid for a minimum 8 days, up to 15 days or up to one month.

The Swiss Holiday Card

The Swiss Holiday Card entitles the holder to unlimited travel by rail, boat and Alpine postal coach. Or to be exact, on the whole network of the Swiss Federal Railways (1810 miles), on 79 private railways (1414 miles), on the lake boat routes (294 nautical or 339 statute miles), and Alpine postal coach routes (2054 miles). All in all, no less than 5600 miles of excursion possibilities within Switzerland. In addition, reductions of 25 - 50% are offered on many funiculars and mountain railways on production of your Swiss Holiday Card.

The procedure is simplicity itself, with only two main basic requirements, Firstly, there must be at least two adults travelling together (two children between the ages of six and twelve counting as one adult) on the outward and return flights. Secondly, the Swiss Holiday Card must be valid for the entire duration of your stay, i.e. either for a period of 8 days, 9 to 15 days or 16 days to one month. The rest is up to you. Simply choose which SWISSAIR flights you wish to travel on from the timetable overleaf. And then from your moment of arrival in Switzerland you are free to travel the length and breadth of this wonderful country.

Plan your own holiday itinerary

You travel by the scheduled services of SWISSAIR from London Heathrow Airport or Manchester and, upon arrival in Switzerland, you can then use your Swiss Holiday Card to travel around the country. You may choose to stay at five star hotels or at little pensions off the beaten track. You can have meals either on the lake boats or at restaurants in the cities, resorts or tiny villages. No couriers to organise you. You are completely your own master.



Bookings

Bookings can be made through your local Travel Agent, your nearest SWISSAIR office, or the Swiss National Tourist Office / Swiss Federal Railways. The following information will be needed at the time of booking, date of birth for any members in your party under the age of 16 years, passport numbers of all party members, type of Swiss Holiday Card needed and your SWISSAIR flight details. Before departure, you will be given the appropriate air tickets and one SWISSAIR voucher per party, the latter being exchanged for your Swiss Holiday Card at any of the Swiss Federal Railway offices mentioned below.

Children under two years of age travel free on the Swiss Federal Railways and pay only 10% of the applicable public air fare.


