LOCARNO — HONEYMOON PACKAGE

Ten hotels and pensions in all price categories are allowing newly wed couples who wish to spend their honeymoon in Locarno the following benefits:

Validity is up to three months from wedding day.

SWISS FEDERAL RAILWAYS — IMPROVEMENTS FOR NON-SMOKERS

The Swiss Federal Railways will be following the public's request to install more non-smoking compartments on their trains. Inquiries have resulted in a desired proportion of seating availability non-smoking/smoking of approximately 66%:34% (2:1). The present proportion is 53:47.

In the next few months 1,410 smoking seats will be classified as non-smoking seats in the corridor carriages of the "Swiss Express" compositions as well as in the corridor carriages of international trains.

By 1982 the "smoking" end-compartments of 674 passenger carriages will also be converted into

non-smoking compartments resulting in another 10,164 seats for non-smokers.

At the end of this scheme the new proportion non-smoking/smoking will be approximately 60:40. Further improvements in favour of non-smokers will be achieved when building new rolling stock.

FRUTIGEN — NEW HOTEL

The new Hotel Rustica has opened its doors at Frutigen in the Bernese Oberland. The hotel has 20 beds, a large restaurant and a modern discothèque.

ZÜRICH — INCENTIVE TOUR

Special inclusive packages are on offer, based on a group of at least 40 persons, with three nights from Sw.Fr. 143 and six nights from Sw.Fr. 260. The cost includes accommodation in twin-bedded rooms, breakfast, transfer from the airport to the hotel, service charge, taxes and a documentation.

A CARPENTRY MUSEUM MOVES INTO CASTLE ALTISHOFEN

The top floor of the 16th century castle of Altishofen situated near Dagmersellen on the road Olten — Lucerne has recently become the locality of a carpentry museum. Exhi-

bited are many different tools used in carpentry as well as in other trades of wood-workmanship. The 160 objects which have been collected so far constitute only a beginning. The museum is open on Saturdays from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.; other visits can be arranged by previous appointment.

SWITZERLAND THE CHEAP WAY

The Swiss Student Travel Service (SSR) has published a new handbook in English called "Switzerland the cheap way". The book is designed for young people who travel in Switzerland and includes information on Swiss politics, history, economy and culture as well as details of cheap eating possibilities, accommodation, entertainment, meeting points for young people and students, unusual excursions, museums, sport activities, etc. A map is also included.

This book is available in Switzerland from the offices of the Swiss Student Travel Service and from specialised book shops. Cost: Sw.Fr. 9.

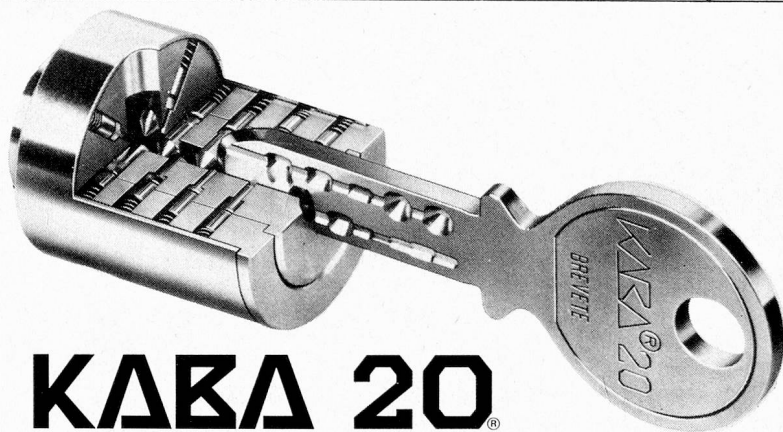
INTERLAKEN — NEW PANORAMA RESTAURANT AT HEIMWEHFLUH

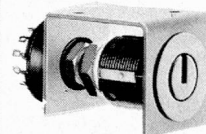
