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It may seem almost a paradox to say that Swiss private schools are better known abroad than in Switzerland. However, there are many reasons for their existence.

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□ It provides a healthy social climate, unaffected by racial, political and religious disputes.

□ It provides an excellent climate and opportunities for tourism.

□ It provides a programme of schooling which allows children to continue studies begun in their own country, while learning one of several foreign languages, in particular French, German or Italian.

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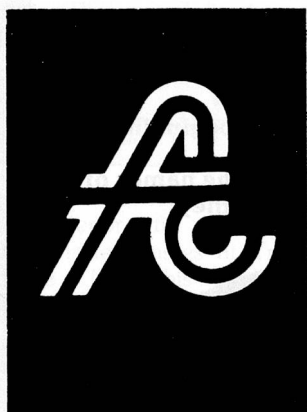
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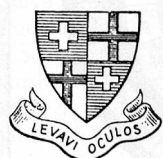
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
