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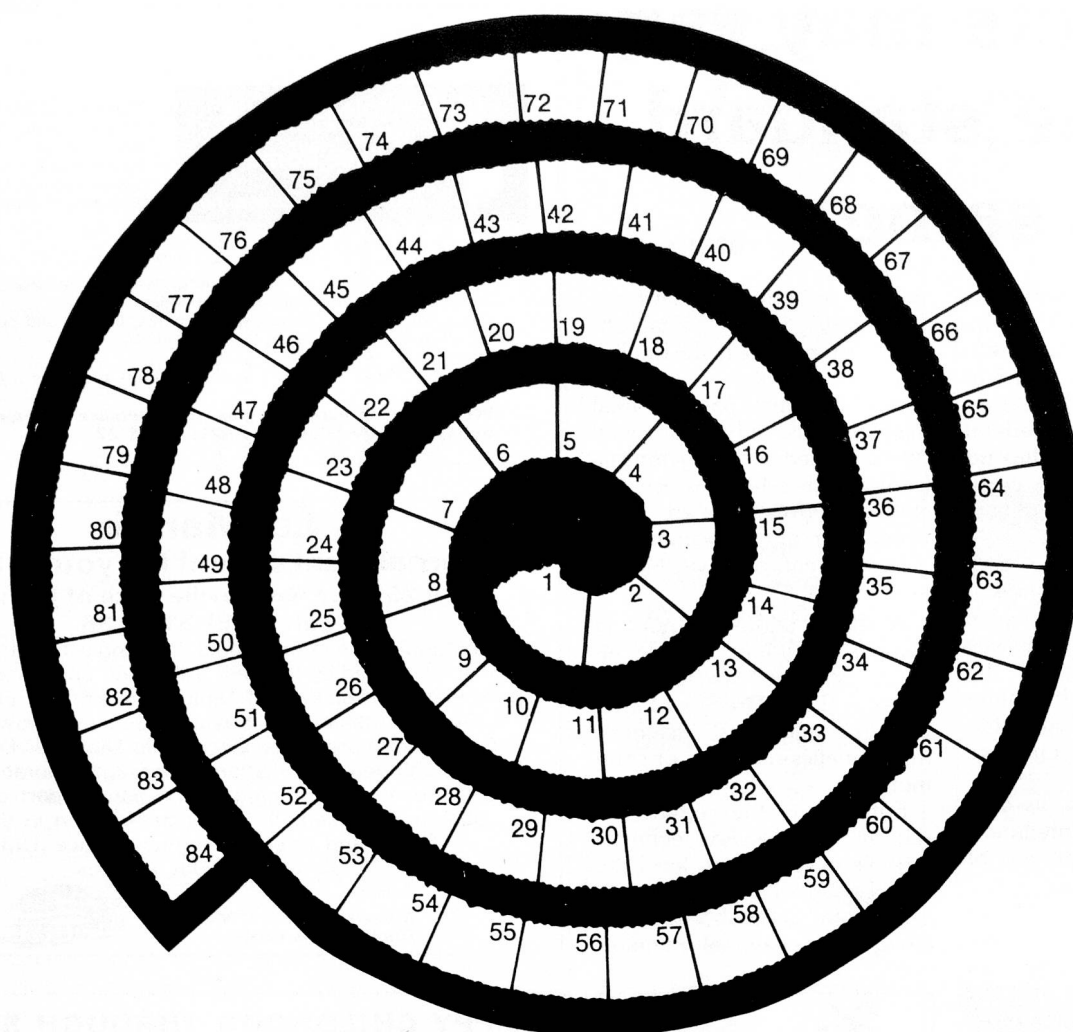
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# Take a turn at the Swiss Roll

Words overlap by one or more letters so that the

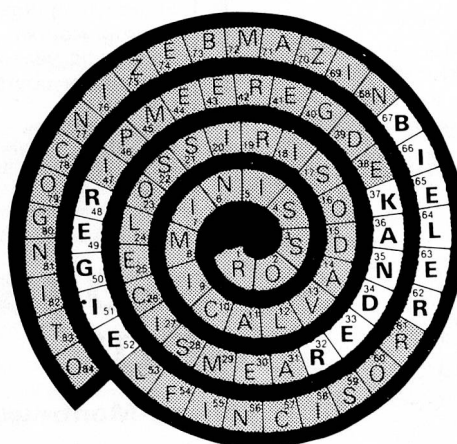
final letter or letters of one word is the beginning of the next word.
