Rhatische Bahn on Video Volume two one hour £24.95

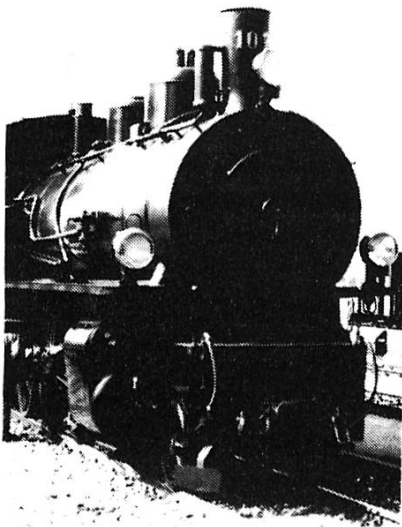
This programme is an extension of Rhatische Bahn on Video Volume One and explores the remote Engadine line to Scuol Tarasp, the sub-Artic wastes and fertile valleys of the Bernina. We also take you through the grandeur of the Albula to Chur, capital town of Graubunden. From Chur we whisk you 3,800 feet in 15.5 miles to Arosa before taking you on the circular trip from Chur to Davos and Filisur. On the other side of the San Bernadino Alpine barrier is the little known remnant of the Misox line between Castione and Grono for you to explore.

2-8-0 steam locomotive number 107, built by SLM in 1906 is still in steam, see her on the Davos and Engadine lines in full flight.

For locomotive fans there are Ge 6/6's, Tm 2/2's (four types), Gm 3/3, Ge 6/6 twos, Ge 4/4 ones and twos, Be 4/4, Te 2/2, Xm 2/2 and lots more including a myriad of railcars.

We also take a step away from the lineside to show you the Bernina, Glacier and Engadine Expresses in magnificent scenery. There are freight and passenger trains of every type and architecture and railway furniture are not forgotten. This is a programme you and your family will want to see again and again.

All one hour programmes have a full commentary by professional voice-over artists. They are written and produced by John Cocking to full television documentary standards. All video material is shot on location in full colour and sound using U-Matic high grade tape. Copies are also on high grade tape.
