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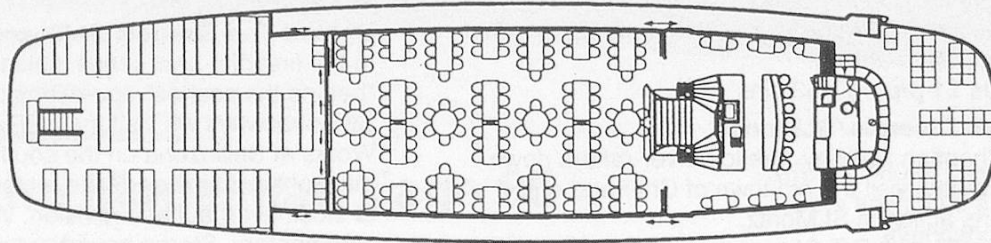
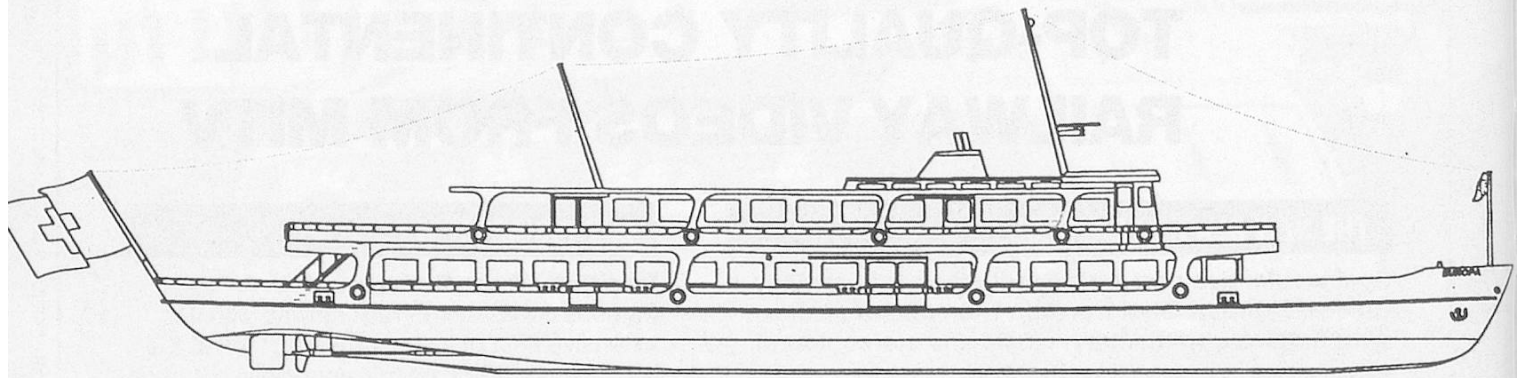
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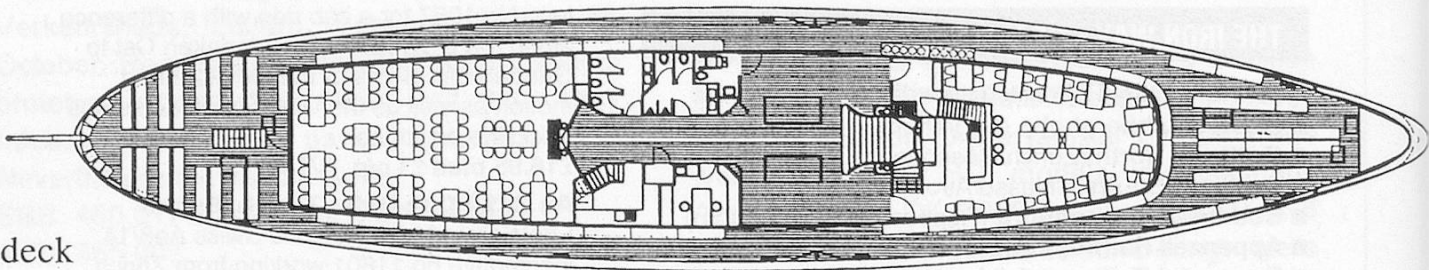

Lake of Luzern, steamer information

The motor vessel 'EUROPA', extensively rebuilt to the standards of the 'Panorama' class after a dockyard fire, had her second 'maiden voyage' in the fair weather on the 12th October 1995. The passengers included about 35 media representatives. The vessel is presently working special services, such as lunch-time cruises, but from next year will take up regular workings.

The motor vessel 'WALDSTATTER', rebuilt

from the ex Thames paddle steamer 'BEN JOHNSON', is to be withdrawn from service at the end of this year.

The next paddle steamer to be refitted will be the 'SCHILLER' the work will take from the end of the 1997 summer season until 2000.

A new motor vessel with a passenger capacity of around 700 is due to go into service during 1997. The name is yet to be decided.
